How the research works

Chinese-source first. Policy and Party-state documents, regulator notices, corporate disclosures, official statistics, local-government records, and Chinese-language reporting establish the institutional record.

Institutions beyond labels. The analysis separates legal ownership from effective control and examines implementation authority, local-government relations, sector policy, financing, and changing permission structures.

Cross-system reading. China is read from inside its institutions, Türkiye as the decision context, and the United States as a major source of regulatory, technology, finance, and geopolitical shocks.

Decision and evidence discipline. Verified findings, analytical inference, uncertainty, and recommended verification steps are separated so clients can see what is known, what remains unresolved, and what to do next.
